Diversity, Unity, and Celebration: CTS' 14th Commencement Exercise

Isn't it beautiful when diverse people come together in unity and celebration? That was the sight to behold during the 14th graduation ceremony of the Colombo Theological Seminary (CTS) held last 15 July 2023 in Colombo. Our very own Dr. Theresa Lua, ATA General Secretary, was privileged to witness the graduation ceremony as she not only gave the graduation message, but likewise awarded the diploma to all the graduates.

This recently held graduation is unlike previous ones because this was the first time the institution held a national graduation from their 9 centers across Sri Lanka. There were 173 graduates- with about 150 in attendance during the ceremony. There were a number who were handed their diplomas posthumously during the ceremony- students who passed away not only because of COVID but also victims during the Easter bombing last 21 April 2019.

Much like the chapel services of CTS, the graduation was in the two major languages of Sri Lanka: Singahali and Tamil. Language has been and continues to be a sensitive issue in Sri Lanka; and the barrier that it has created has contributed to regional conflicts. So, to be inclusive, CTS always uses both Singhali and Tamil. Dr. Lua's full message was printed





in the souvenir program in three languages: English, Singhali, and Tamil.

Two days before the ceremony, CTS held a banquet- where Dr. Lua not only gave a short message but also surprised all those present with a duet with Dr. Ivor Poobalan, Principal, Colombo Theological Seminary. CTS likewise arranged for Dr. Lua to meet with some students to provide an overview of ATA and have lunch fellowship with them. A separate session with the whole faculty was also arranged for her to make a presentation about ATA-particularly on the new Accreditation Manual and ATA's strategic initiatives. The Q&A that followed focused on accreditation, online learning, and current issues and challenges in Theological Education.

After her time in CTS, Dr. Lua then proceeded from Colombo to Peradeniya to meet with the leaders of Lanka Bible College and Seminary. She had a good conversation with them about quality assurance and other issues in Theological Education.

We praise God for how He brings unity and even celebration amid the most diverse peoples- and the CTS graduation 2023 is proof of that!



Asian Christian Theology now available in Bahasa and Hindi!

As part of our goal to expand and deepen the reach of our publications, along with widening its access, we, along with Langham Publishing, have endeavored to commission high quality translations of our most strategic Publications. We have begun with the translation of our recently published Asian Christian Theology- and aim to have this resource available in all major Asian Languages.

This year, we have been able to complete and are moving towards the completion of its translations in both Bahasa and Nepali.

The Bahasa translation "Teologi Kristen Asia" was done in partnership with the publishing department of the Seminari Alkitab Asia Tenggara (Southeast Asia Bible Seminary)- formerly known as Sekolah tingi Teologi SAAT. Purchasing details are in the photo of the eflyer on the right.

The team behind Teologi Kristen Asia hopes that it will be useful for Indonesian theologians in doing theology in their specific contexts.

On the other hand, the Hindi translation is being done in partnership with Open Door Publications Pvt Ltd, India. The Hindi translation of Asian Christian Theology is a significant step for India's Hindispeaking evangelical community and the diaspora. Bringing a companion textbook into the heart language, the students and faculty of theology in seminaries and institutions in India will engage with the core doctrines of Christianity in their own language for the first time. This is a historic achievement.

While still underway, it is nearing completion and will available starting October 2023 through Open




